*The community of Catholic Youth Camp embraces a respectful, supportive and inclusive environment where each person can feel safe and grow. Although campers are encouraged to express themselves openly and honestly with each other, staff and all members of the CYC community, a specific level of conduct is expected. To achieve this, the following behavioral expectations have been established.*

- Guests will treat their peers, CYC staff, volunteers, and camp guests with respect at all times, including the display of respect for another’s feelings and privacy.
- Guests will remain in designated camp program areas at all times or have permission to go to other areas of camp.
- Guests will follow directions of all CYC staff and designated volunteers.
- Guests will not use obscene or offensive language or gestures while participating in and/or being transported to/from CYC or designated CYC activities/events.
- Guests may disagree with others, but they are expected to share their disagreement calmly and privately with the person or persons with whom they disagree.

If a guest is unsuccessful in meeting the behavioral expectations of Catholic Youth Camp, a meeting with the Executive Director will be set up to determine steps to correct the situation. If exhaustive efforts do not succeed, the guest may be asked to leave camp. A refund will not be given. For more information, please contact the CYC Office.

**The following behaviors are considered extremely serious and will result in the immediate dismissal from camp:**

- Possession and/or use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, narcotics, illicit drugs, drug-related paraphernalia, and all other controlled substances.
- Possession and/or use of any type of weapon including, but not limited to guns, knives, and martial arts type weapons, etc.
- Any behavior that seriously compromises the safety and/or well being of any camper, camp staff, volunteer, or guest.

**ALL GUESTS ATTENDING CATHOLIC YOUTH CAMP MUST ANNUALLY HAVE A SIGNED COPY OF THIS AGREEMENT ON FILE, IN ORDER TO PARTICIAPTE IN ANY CAMP ACTIVITIES OR EVENTS.**

We have read and understand the Behavioral Expectation Agreement. We have discussed the behavioral expectations for participants attending Catholic Youth Camp and we agree to abide by the statements in this agreement.
